



Membership Guidelines

1. The U3A(PO) is an Association for the English-speaking community of the Pyrénées Orientales. Its aims are:
 - a. to advance the cultural and educational interests of its members
 - b. to provide leisure and recreational activities in order to improve the conditions of life and welfare of its members.
2. Although, as the name suggests, we are of the “Third Age” we have no age discrimination. The nature and timing of the activities suggest that it is suitable for those of us who have retired from full time work.
3. All members are expected to be active participators in some way to the groups to which they belong and/or to the Association as a whole, in order to keep it running smoothly.

Terms and Conditions of Membership

1. Members must be non-judgemental; respect the views and accept the differences of others; treat everyone with respect and courtesy and without harassment; and refrain from harming the organisation’s reputation.
2. The annual membership fee is due before the end of May each year. Failure to pay may result in membership being withdrawn.
3. Changes to members’ details, e.g. telephone number or email address must be sent to the Membership Secretary.
4. Family members and visitors are welcome to join in activities if there is room. Members must be given priority. A 2 Euro temporary membership fee per guest per event attended should be handed to a committee member/co-ordinator who will forward it to the Treasurer. It is the responsibility of the member who brings along a guest to ensure that the 2 Euro temporary membership fee is paid. This is to comply with insurance conditions, children under 18 are not covered by our U3A PO Third party insurance.
5. Those English speakers who live locally may attend ONE session as a taster on payment of the 2 Euro temporary membership fee. Thereafter they are expected to join – they cannot continue to keep coming as guests. Co-ordinators – you must get the names of guests to ensure that this is adhered to comply with our Insurance policy covering a third party.
6. Our events are not usually open to (and not usually suitable for) children. Requests to incorporate children should be made to the Group Co-ordinator and all group members.
7. Dogs are only accepted to individual group events with the agreement of all members and the Group Coordinator. Otherwise our events are not open to dogs.
8. We have no facility for and no intention of providing any form of advertising. Other locally based publications and websites provide this kind of facility and we suggest members use this for any advertisement of services etc.
9. In order to maintain privacy, we do not circulate members’ details. If a Group Coordinator wishes to do this, permission must be sought from the group members. All communications must be sent bcc/icc to minimise the risk of hacking etc.

10. Participation in U3A activities is at member's own risk and with his/her own insurance cover and neither the U3A PO Committee nor the coordinators/facilitators/leaders are responsible for any injuries, mishaps or losses that may occur.
11. The information provided on the Membership application form will be held on a computer database and used only in connection with U3A PO activities. These details will never be knowingly passed to a third party outside of the U3A PO
12. In keeping with the U3A PO Data Privacy Policy photographs may be taken whilst participating in U3A PO trips, events or group activities. These photographs may be used on the U3A PO website. If you do not want your photograph published then you must inform the coordinators/facilitators/leaders, especially before group photographs are taken which are clearly intended for the website. In this case you should absent yourself from the group before the photograph is taken.
13. Members must not use the Association to promote any personal business or cause.
